TODAY'S READINGS

CHRISTIAN HOSPITALITY

Day in and day out, we are required to make judgment calls informed by tough, durable, serviceable Christian love. We do what we can do, and God takes notice. God is in charge of rewards, and a glass of water will do when that is what we have to offer with a glad and open heart.

Paul gives us a clear theology for the missionary work we do whenever anybody is close at hand. He reminds us that our work, our ministry, is carried on in concert with Christ. We have been baptized into his death and life. In any given moment both life and death are there, a kind of play of shadow and light. Sometimes it's difficult to tell where shadow leaves off and light begins. God will take care of that, too.

SŁOWO BOŻE NA DZISIEJSZĄ NIEDZIELĘ

Pierwsze czytanie – *Szunemitka przyjmuje proroka.* 2 Krl 4,8-11.14-16a

OTWARTOŚĆ NA KAŻDEGO CZŁOWIEKA

Słowa Jezusa: „Kto was przyjmuje, Mnie przyjmuje; a kto Mnie przyjmuje, przyjmuje Tego, który Mnie posłał” są zachętą do pogłębionej refleksji na temat gościnności. Nie chodzi o jakiegokolwiek zaproszenie do wspólnego stołu, ale o zaproszenie ze względu na Chrystusa. Tylko wtedy w przychodzącym człowieku potrafimy dostrzec Jezusa. Tradycja wielkodusznej gościnności jest bardzo żywa w tradycji żydowskiej, o czym świadczy wiele fragmentów ze Starego Testamentu, jak choćby spotkanie Abrahama z trzema tajemniczymi wędrowcami (Rdz 18, 1-33). Nieustannie pogłębiajmy otwartość serca ze względu na Boga. Tylko On może odblokować wszelkie hamulce, które sprawiają, że nie potrafimy zaufać drugiemu człowiekowi, bo zbyt koncentrujemy się na sobie, swoich potrzebach, zranieniach lub oczekiwaniach.

Jezu! Zachwyca mnie Twoja otwartość na każdego człowieka. Ucz mnie zaufania pomimo zranień, niespełnionych potrzeb czy obojętności drugiego człowieka.

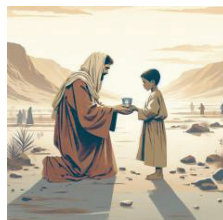

FAMILY CONNECTION

One can tell a lot about a family by the way they welcome others into their home. Despite parental efforts to elicit the best behavior from their children, family efforts to entertain guests are sometimes difficult. Practicing a spirit of Christian hospitality within the family can be an occasion to

reflect upon the importance of this virtue. A family spirit of hospitality is a sign of faith. When your family gathers, ask each person to consider the following questions about manners: What does it mean to be a good host? What does it mean to be a good guest? Invite each person to share their thoughts and experiences about being a guest or a host. When they have finished, read aloud today's Gospel, Matthew 10:37-42.

Ask family members to describe what Jesus says about hospitality extended to his disciples. (Those who receive Jesus' disciples also receive Jesus himself; hospitality to Jesus' disciples will be rewarded.) Then encourage family members to talk about what it means to be a good guest or a good host. You might also talk about ways in which your family's hospitality might be improved upon. Conclude in prayer together that your family grows to be one in which Christian hospitality is experienced by all. Pray together the Lord's Prayer or today's Psalm.

Veneration of the two great Apostles, Peter and Paul, has its roots in the very foundations of the Church.

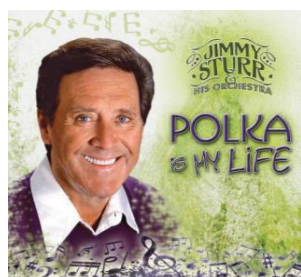
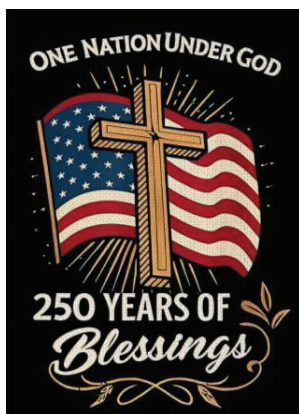

He was buried on the hill of the Vatican where recent excavations have revealed his tomb on the very site of the basilica of St. Peter's. St. Paul was beheaded in the via Ostia on the spot where now stands the basilica bearing his name. Down the centuries Christian people in their thousands have gone on pilgrimage to the tombs of these Apostles.

WSPOMNIENIA LITURGICZNE

29 czerwca - Św. Apostołów Piotra i Pawła



Św. Piotr pochodził z Betsaidy, miejscowości położonej nad Jeziorem Genezaret. Był bratem św. Andrzeja Apostoła, który go przyprowadził do Pana Jezusa. Właściwym imieniem św. Piotra było imię Szymon. Pan Jezus zmienił mu je na Piotr zaraz podczas pierwszego spotkania: "A Jezus wejrząwszy na niego rzekł: "Ty jesteś Szymon, syn Jana, ty będziesz nazywał się Kefas to znaczy: Piotr". Św. Piotr w swojej spuściźnie literackiej zostawił dwa Listy, które należą do ksiąg Pisma Świętego. Napisane zostały w latach 63-64. Kult św. Piotra sięga samych początków chrześcijaństwa. Zaraz po jego śmierci oddawano mu cześć jako następcy Pana Jezusa i Jego pierwszemu namiestnikowi na ziemi.



Św. Paweł urodził się w Tarsie około 8. roku po narodzeniu Chrystusa. Urodził się jako obywatel rzymski, co mu dawało pewne przywileje. Nadano mu imię Saul (polskie Szawel). Rodzina Szawła należała do stronnictwa faryzeuszów. Imię Paweł – pochodzenia łacińskiego, znaczy „niskiego wzrostu”. Paweł, początkowo brał udział w prześladowaniach chrześcijan, ale po nawróceniu, zaczął głosić Ewangelię, zakładał liczne wspólnoty. Aresztowany, mieszkał w Rzymie przez trzy lata. Tam też został stracony za czasów Nerona, około 65 roku. Św. Paweł pozostawił po sobie najbogatszą literaturę, bo aż 14 Listów. Liturgia łączy w jednej uroczystości: Piotra - głowę Kościoła i Pawła - Apostoła narodów. Obydwaj są żywym fundamentem Kościoła zbudowanego ich trudami, a w końcu użyźnionego ich męczeństwem.

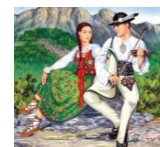

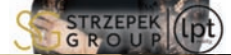
